- 3. The Lockney City Council shall deliberate, consider and take action on the Broker's analysis from Kim Street at Street Real Estate presented by Brent Barker on behalf of the Lockney Economic Development Corporation for the sale of the property at 210 N. Main Street.**
- 4. The Lockney City Council shall consider and take action to approve and adopt a Resolution ordering a General Election at large to be held on May 2, 2026, for the election of a Mayor and two council members.**
- 5. The Lockney City Council shall deliberate and consider a joint election contract with Lockney Independent School District for the upcoming general election on May 2, 2026. The council may take action.**
- 6. The Lockney City Council shall deliberate and take action to approve a contract with Floyd County regarding the May 2, 2026 City of Lockney general election to be conducted by the Floyd County Clerk's office.**
- 7. The Lockney City Council shall deliberate and consider an ordinance outlawing abortion, declaring Lockney a Sanctuary City for the Unborn, making various provisions and findings, providing for severability, and establishing an effective date.**

8. The Lockney City Council shall review a Resolution of the City of Lockney authorizing the filing of a grant application with the South Plains Association of Governments for a regional solid waste grants program grant; authorizing KayCee Thiebaud, Interim City Manager to act on behalf of City of Lockney in all matters related to the application; and pledging that if a grant is received City of Lockney will comply with the grant requirements of the South Plains Association of Governments, the Texas Commission On Environmental Quality and the State of Texas. The Council may take action.
9. The Lockney City Council shall consider the appointment of KayCee Thiebaud as a City of Lockney representative on the Mackenzie Municipal Water Authority Board of Directors to fill the vacancy for Buter Poling's appointment. The Council may take action.


